

Kettle Moraine State Forest Northern Unit Bridle Trail Map

GENERAL INFO

Horse Trails – All horse trails are open late April through November. The main linear trail is 33.4 miles long.

Camping – New Prospect Horserider's Campground is centrally located, adjacent to the bridle trail.

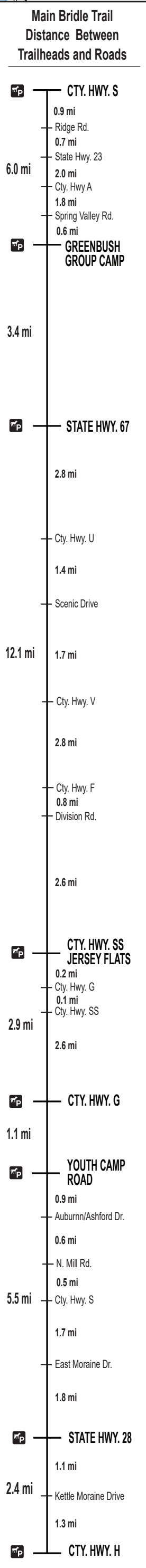
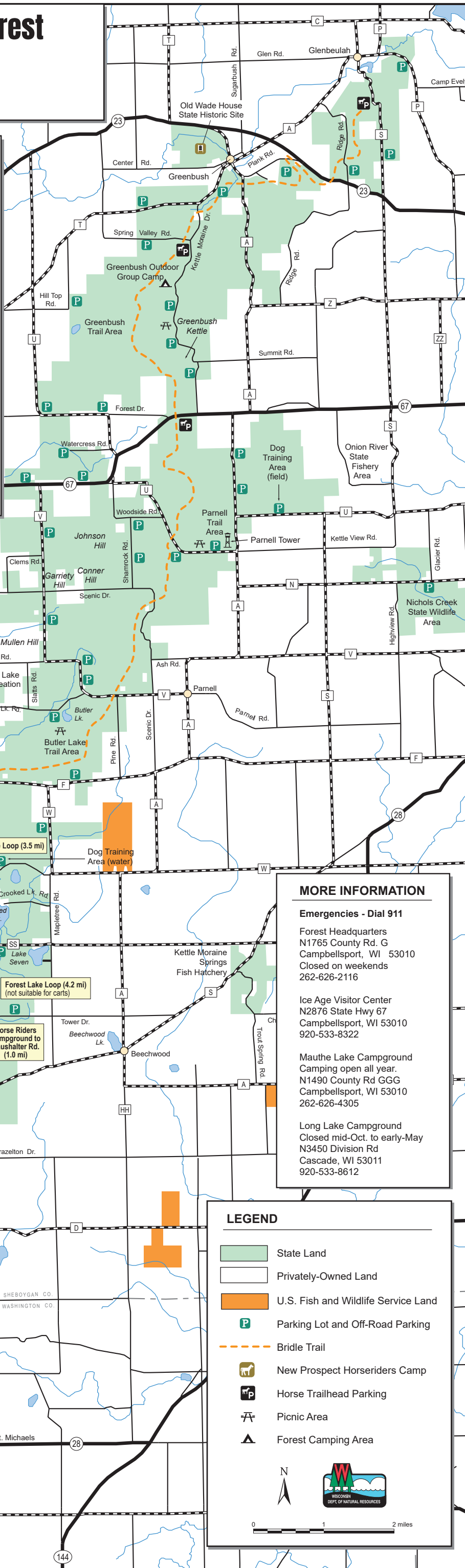
Vehicle Admission Stickers – All vehicles parked in designated use areas must have a state park sticker.

Trail Passes – All horse riders age 16 years or older are required to purchase and carry a valid state trail pass while using designated horse trails.

Hunting – Approximately 95% of the forest is open to public hunting during established seasons. All trail users are encouraged to wear blaze orange or bright colored clothing during hunting seasons.

Road Signs – Signs identifying the road the trail crosses are located on the left at most crossings.

Mileage Markers – Markers are positioned every mile along the main trail starting from the south by Hwy H. "Mile 1" is 1 mile north of Hwy H; "Mile 26" is 26 miles north of Hwy H, etc.
